The Banks Bulldogs Football Club was established in 1978 as a founding member of the Carlton United Sunday competition, the forerunner of the Northern Territory Football Association being formed in 1982, in recent years becoming known as TEAFA. Last season the TEAFA merged with the NTFL forming a three tiered competition.

Since 1978, Banks A Grade have won 9 premierships and been runner up 14 times. That's an incredible 23 Grand Final appearances in 33 seasons.

The Reserves competition was established in 1992, and our famous Killer B's have won 7 premierships and been runner up 8 times in 19 seasons.

The Club's first ever game was played as a social match between the Commonwealth Bank and Westpac. After the match it was thought we could perhaps form a 'proper' side. Banks Bulldogs took on the NTFL C Grade sides as well as Pints and Combined Services.

Over the next few years the make up of the competition saw new sides come including Katherine, Jabiru and Tracy Village with University joining later.

During these changing times Banks have always had a competitive playing group and a strong committee, something that continues today.

The football club in the early years was run on a very small budget and sponsorship was minimal. Our sole sponsor for many years was CUB and our motto 'Powered by Fosters' which was taken seriously by the playing group.

Players filled almost all committee positions and social functions were well patronised and enthusiastically attended. The early 1980's saw several changes that have left lasting legacies on the Club.

Life long friendships and lasting fond memories are things Banks Football Club offered and continue to do so.

AWARDS, CRITERIA AND VOTING



President's Award

The four criteria in selecting the recipient;

- The person should be non-committee and act in an unpaid capacity
- Consistency of service throughout the year
- Demonstrated selflessness and initiative in not having to be asked
- And embracing this years' Club ethos which is "getting it done".

Player's Player Award

This highly esteemed award goes to a player that demonstrates 'Outstanding Service' to the Club as voted upon by his team mates.

Only members that have played at least one game in the current season may vote using a 3, 2, 1 system.

Voting will be completed at the conclusion of the minor round season.

Revised Match Day Voting System

In 2011/2012, the Club will be adopting a 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 voting system.

For consistency, the following positions at the Club will be responsible for awarding Best & Fairest votes at the conclusion of each minor round;

Division 1 Coach Assistant Coach Committee Member or Delegate Division 2 Coach Assistant Coach Committee Member or Delegate



AFLNT Send Off Rule

- (a) A Player REPORTED (other than those recognised in "The Laws of Australian Football 19.2.2) will be sent off for a **RED CARD** offence and cannot be replaced for 10 minutes of elapsed playing time as determined by the Timekeepers and **cannot** return to the field for the remainder of that match.
- (b) Players sent off for a YELLOW CARD offence cannot be replaced for 10 minutes of elapsed playing time as determined by the Timekeepers and can return to the field. A player sent off for a second yellow card offence in the same match automatically is deemed to have received a RED CARD and cannot return to the field for the remainder of that match.

Any "PLAYER" who receives three yellow cards in any one season shall automatically be suspended for 1 week in their next clubs scheduled match and shall be ineligible to win any League Best and Fairest award.

The AFL LAWS OF AUSTRALIAN FOOTBALL rules under; 19.2.2 SPECIFIC OFFENCES

- (g) Intentionally, recklessly or negligently
 - (iv) Engaging in Time Wasting;
 - (viii) Engaging in a melee, except where a Player's sole intention is to remove a teammate from the incident
- (h) Attempting to kick another person;
- (i) Attempting to strike another person;
- (j) Attempting to trip another person whether by hand, arm, foot or leg;
- (k) Intentionally shaking a goal or behind post when another Player is preparing to Kick or is Kicking for Goal or after the Player has Kicked for Goal and the ball is in transit;
- (o) Wearing boots, jewellery and equipment prohibited under Law 9;

IMPORTANT BY-LAWS

Player Qualification

4.5.2 Senior Grade, Division One

Minor Round

(d) If a Club has a bye in Division One, a player who played their last match in Division One is eligible to play in a lower division if they have played 50% or more of their matches in that division.

4.5.7 Senior Grade, Division One

Major Round

- (a) A player who has played in a Premier League major round match is eligible to play in a Senior Grade, Division One Major Round match after the Premier League team has been eliminated from the Major round if they have played a minimum of 50% of the minor round matches in a Division or Grade lower than Premier League.
- (b) A player who has played more than 50% of their individual matches in Premier League during a NTFL season is ineligible to play in a Senior Grade, Division One Major Round match unless the Premier League team is playing in that same Major Round.

4.5.8 Senior Grade, Division Two

Major Round

- (a) A player who has played in a Senior Grade, Division One major round match is eligible to play in a Senior Grade, Division Two Major Round match after the Senior Grade, Division One team has been eliminated from the Major round if they have played a minimum of 50% of the minor round matches in a Division or Grade lower than Senior Grade, Division One.
- (b) A player who has played more than 50% of their individual matches in Senior Grade, Division One during a NTFL season is ineligible to play in a Senior Grade, Division Two Major Round match unless the Senior Grade, Division One team is playing in that same Major Round.





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
