CLIVE PALMER JUNIOR SPORT EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP



Queensland Nickel enjoys its commitment and association with junior sport and Townsville Basketball. It is therefore, very exciting to announce the third round of the Queensland Nickel "Clive Palmer Junior Sport Education Scholarship" to two chosen athletes from basketball.

The Clive Palmer Junior Sport Education Scholarship is designed to assist these two young athletes' financially in their healthy lifestyle with educational support for the 2013 year. The education scholarship will be offered to

- One Under 16 player (scholarship of \$500)
- One Under 18 player (scholarship of \$1,000)

Townsville Basketball will liaise with each winner's respective School / TAFE College and these funds will be paid directly to the school to go towards school & education fees for the 2013 year.

What's it involve for the successful 'Clive Palmer Scholarship' recipient

- Grant (financial) assistance by Queensland Nickel (through Townsville Basketball) to assist with education fees for the 2013 year. (paid directly by TBI to the school)
- Provide goals for improvement on a regular basis both short and long term.
- General assessment of the successful athlete's current level, needs, general approach to the game of basketball. The athletes will receive on-going monitoring / assessment to best support all aspects of play / involvement required for the respective player's progression and development.

The program will be under the direction of Townsville Basketball who will report regularly with Queensland Nickel.

Details and eligibility for applicants

Applications will be advertised by Townsville Junior Basketball. Applications are open to all interested registered junior players who in the 2013 year will be between the ages of 14 to 17 years of age. Applications close on Friday 14 September 2012.

Townsville Junior Basketball will appoint a Selection Panel and using the below selection criteria as a guide.

From applications, two athletes (one Under 16 player / one Under 18 player) will be invited to be the scholarship recipients for the 2013 year. These two recipients and family will be required to attend the presentation of Queensland Nickel's Clive Palmer Junior Sport Scholarship Awards in October 2012 (date to be confirmed) and may from time to time be called upon other such events.

Selection Criteria

Athletes must be 14 to 17 years of age and must be registered players with Townsville Basketball.

- **Club Contribution:** volunteer time assisting with coaching and club activities
- **Credibility:** Potential, desire and attitude to compete successfully at all games and training and creditability of attendance.
- **Respect:** Potential to be socially compatible and display a sense of 'team ethics'. Respect and behaviour to peers, coaches, team, referees
- **Accountability:** Demonstrated desire to succeed not only in basketball, but in education and personal life. Accountability, demonstrated leadership, advocates teamwork
- **Results:** On field performance
