Registration Information

The 2013 Summer Comp will commence on Monday 4th February 2013

To Enter:

Independent Teams:

- Complete player registration form enclosed with all details, please make sure you have an email address on the form.
- Please return all forms and fees to stadium
- Our deadline for teams will be 8th December 2013
- Late entry fee of \$50.00 will be enforced after 17th January 2013
- Fixtures will be available on MDBA website from 28th January 2013 available for the team contact on the first round starting Monday 4th February 2013

Club Teams:

- Club registration managers to complete team entries.
- All players to pay all registration fees to club.

****** Coaches and Team Managers of all junior teams are required to obtain a Working With Children Check. Working with Children Check card number is required on registration form.**

******* Registration forms will only be accepted with payment of 5 players or more *******

*******A penalty of \$200 will apply to any team that withdraws from competition anytime after the 4th round of the season*******

*******Junior player age cut-off dates: 31st Dec 2013 (Players must be under age in 31/12/2013)**

*******Team contacts must be over 18 years of age.**

Players are not permitted to play in more than 1 Section within a grade..

REGISTRATION FEES:

Juniors - \$30.00 (per player per seasons)

Seniors - \$225.00 per team per season

MIXED, SUPER COMPS & MONDAY LADIES COMPETITION TEAMS - \$160.00 per team per season

MENS SUPER A - \$225.00 PER TEAM PER SEASON

GAME FEES:

Junior - \$8.00 per player per game

Senior: \$50.00 per team sheet per game

Mixed Competitions: \$8.00 per player per game

Super A Competition: \$50.00 per team sheet per game

**A minimum of 5 players game fees must be paid at all games – Juniors \$40.00 Seniors - \$50.00
Mixed \$40.00**

FORFEIT FINES:

Notified Forfeits: Forfeits must be advised 2 working days in advance to the stadium

Unnotified Forfeits: Forfeits without warning or with **less than 2 working days notice.**

Notified: Junior - \$35.00 Senior - \$50.00 Super A - \$30.00 Mixed & Monday Ladies- \$50.00

Unnotified: Junior - \$50.00 Senior - \$80.00 Super A - \$100.00 Mixed & Monday Ladies- \$80.00

Uniforms

- All players must wear matching singlets and the same colour shorts by the commencement of **round 4** of each season.
- **Penalties apply for incorrect uniform after round 3.**
- Singlets cannot be reversed and cannot use "00". **No's 1,2 and 3 are NOT allowed.** Correct numbers are 4-15,20-25,30-35,40-45,50-55. Numbers must be legible from both front and back.
- **Player with Singlets with illegible numbers are not permitted to take the court.**
- A set of singlets/bibs can be hired from the stadium for \$10.00 per game. May borrow singlets in a colour clash situation for free. Clubs have priority in colour clash and first named teams on scoresheet for independent teams.
- A player may wear incorrect shorts but the team will be penalized by 3 points being awarded to the other side. Short colours must be the same colours ie: Navy & Royal Blue are not the same colour, nor red & maroon.
- **Pockets** in shorts are **not** permitted.
- **No ¾ length leggings permitted.**
- **No T-shirts** allowed under basketball singlets (Skins and singlets of any colour, round or V neck accepted).

- **Jewellery:** Rings not accepted to be worn (only securely taped flat wedding rings allowed)
- No bracelets or necklaces allowed.
- **Hair Accessories:** No plastic hair slides combs or clips to be worn on the basketball court. Bobby pins are allowed. No metal/hard plastic headbands are permitted. Material headbands are accepted if they are less than 2cm in width (FIBA rules). Braided beads are not permitted.

Privacy Information:

By lodgement and payment of registration for the coming season, you authorise the use by the MDBA of your name, fame, image, likeness, voice, visual portrayal and reputation in the context of the sport for the purpose of advertising, promoting and marketing the sport of basketball and the MDBA.

Scoring:

Each team is to provide a competent scorer, **over the age of 14 years**, for each of their games. If a team fails to provide a scorer then a player must sit off and score the game.

Eligibility for Finals:

Eligibility for all finals is **signature's** on the back of the scoresheet for **50% plus ONE**, of games played for the season. Bye's do not count as games or part of the season. EG:

Example 1: - 17 games per season – 9 games to qualify to play finals.

Example 2: 17 games with 2 bye's = 15 games – 8 games to qualify to play finals

Sin Bin Ruling:

The Sin Bin is implemented in all competitions for juniors and seniors.

Whereby a player who receives a **Technical Foul** , a **Bench Technical Foul** or an **Unsportmanlike Foul** will be forced to sit on the bench for a period of 5 minutes of playing time.

A Technical foul of a Technical nature is not a Sin Bin rule.

CHANGES to the Junior Representative Players Rule: Extract from By-Laws

In order to try and present a fairer and more even competition for our domestic teams each junior team is only permitted to have 3 representative players in total. The Super A Comps have an exemption from the REP RULE.

- 5.9 No Junior Representative players may be added as fill ins if a team already has 3 Junior Representative players registered with that team. Individuals will be regarded as Junior Representative players if they:
- i Play with a Representative team anytime during the current Championship season. (Summer & Winter Domestic Competitions)
 - ii Played in a Representative team anytime during the previous Championship season. (Summer Domestic Competition)
 - iii The onus is on the team to follow the correct rules. Teams who play ineligible players in any game will forfeit that game.
- 5.10 Teams with more than 3 representative players are permitted to play up an age group, NOT A DIVISION, without penalty.
- 5.11 This rule is effective from 1st January 2012 and for all age group competition up to and including U20 Boys & Girls. Game sheets will be checked to ensure compliance with the rule.
- 5.12 The Domestic Committee has the power to accept or reject any application in order to try and present a fair and even competition for all domestic teams
- 5.13 In the event of a player being ineligible to play in semi finals and finals matches under the condition of By-Laws 3 (3), the player may through his team apply to the Association in writing for permission to play finals matches. The application must outline clearly valid and genuine reasons for the application. The decision by the Domestic Committee shall be deemed final.
