

A player and coach for more than 30 years, Craig played 148 games and has coached Melbourne Storm in 231 games for an amazing 68% winning ratio since being appointed head coach in 2003.

Craig Bellamy has an unprecedented finals record with the Storm playing finals every year from 2006 to 2012 excluding 2010, making the Grand Final on five occasions and winning three Premierships along the way.
