

In 2012 a serious playing incident in a country football match resulted in a Leongatha player becoming permanently paralysed. The ongoing costs associated with the management of his condition far outweigh the sum that was available through his club's insurance cover. Should such a

tragedy have occurred in an EFL match in 2012, the maximum payout available was capped at \$100,000.

The EFL has now arranged insurance cover that provides \$1 million for injuries that result in permanent paraplegia or quadriplegia. To our knowledge this will be the highest level of cover for this type of injury provided to any entire competition nationally.

There is of course a cost associated with acquiring this cover. In 2013 we have introduced a means by which all individuals registered to play EFL football will each year pay a small EFL registration fee. Registration fees are not new, until this season clubs paid these on behalf of their players.

The new registration fees have been set to cover not just a small portion of the administrative costs of running the league but to cover the costs of this new insurance cover. Clubs will no longer be charged EFL player registration fees. The registration fee for under 19 and senior players (including veterans) will be \$20.00, inclusive of GST.

All EFL registered players will continue to be provided personal accident and loss of income insurance that will still be paid for by your club. For more information on the level of cover provided go to www.eflinsurance.com.au/.

To register to play in 2013 each player will be required go to our web site (www.efl.org.au) and click the large "Player Registration" link on the home page to input your personal Username: **«Username»** Password: **«Password»**

When you do so you will need to update or add your contact details and pay the 2013 Registration Fee using a Visa or Mastercard.

Switching to an on-line player registration format will require some adjustment but the long term benefits are considerable. Players will view and manage their own records and the EFL and your club will be able to communicate with you directly.

Should you have any concerns or difficulties in managing your registration or payment I would encourage you to speak with your club representative who will be able to assist you.

We look forward to another season of EFL football and thank you for your support in further improving the way that we go about managing the competitions.
