1. ACTION POINTS

1.1 Club Affiliation

Pursuant to a review of the AFLGSJ Affiliation requirements and the changes to the competition bylaws (3.1 - 3.10) we are now introducing an annual affiliation process which will commence in February and is expected to be completed by April 1 each year, extended to June 1 this year only.

The decision to move to an annual requirement was taken after some consideration of the need to assist Clubs and their members meeting the legal and financial requirements of incorporation, and are ensuring they are adequately protected with respect to the GSJ insurance arrangements.

In 2013, the attached form details the documents that must be lodged with GSJ Administration by the above date. In the interim period, and pending receipt of each Club's Affiliation documents, all Clubs are granted provisional affiliation
