Registration Fees 2013

The club has now established its exact registration fees for 2013, it will be \$290 (which includes a \$30 refundable deposit for their jumper) for a senior player and \$140 for a registered under eighteens player.

This entitles players to all the necessary playing and training equipment, coaching, and limited insurance.

Coaches have agreed to implement a no pay no play policy for

Players are expected to have paid their full registration fees by the Thursday night prior to round I in April (4th)or they will be considered unavailable for selection.

If a player is unable to meet this requirement, they can make a payment plan with treasurer

Blake Parker which must be kept to. Failure to do this will result in the player being deemed unavailable for selection.

Should a new player come after or within a month prior to the due date, they will be required to pay \$50 to cover their necessary playing equipment, and then will be required to pay the balance within one month from the time they register with the club.
