Comments:	<p>The Hawks took on top of table Oakleigh at a soggy and windy Le Page 2 oval and came away with a great victory and an even more important lesson of not giving up when you are behind, because the old saying of "footy is a funny game" definitely rang true.</p> <p>We kicked the first 2 goals courtesy of quick ball movement and great play reading by Watto with the breeze. Captain Emmo lead from the front with great attacking play from 1/2 back and Webby and Robbo in the middle got the ball moving forward. I t was a hard fought contest that set the tone for the rest of the game. The Oaks really attacked us in the second quarter and led by 15 points at half time. We absorbed some really strong play and battled hard against the strong breeze but were lucky to be that close as their kicking was a bit wayward.
