



Junior Scholarship Award

The Yachting Northern Territory (YNT) junior scholarship is an initiative of YNT and is intended to provide encouragement for junior sailors who are competing at a National or International level. The scholarship is open to all junior members of YNT affiliated sailing clubs and the winner for each club will receive a grant of \$500.00 that will be presented at their club presentation ceremony or similar event by the YNT President.

Nominations for the scholarship close on 31 October each year and nominations must be received by the YNT Secretary no later than 5 November of that year. Nominations must be for achievements throughout the past year and will be assessed by a panel appointed by YNT. The decision of the panel will be final and no appeals or correspondence will be entered into. Applicants must be nominated by their member club or class association and must use the official nomination form (additional pages may be added if necessary). Nominations addressing the following criteria should be addressed to

- Be a financial member of YNT.
- Be a financial member of a YNT affiliated club.
- Be no older than nineteen years of age at the start of the year of nomination.
- Compete in National and or International competition in the year of nomination.
- Demonstrate a willingness to share their knowledge to other club or association members.
- Display good character and fair sportsmanship at all times.

YNT is proud to provide the opportunity to encourage a high level of competition and award junior sailors who extend their horizons beyond the club level.
