

Caleb Harrison has recently returned to Canterbury as the Regional Talent Programme head coach after spending ten years coaching in the United States. Harrison has most recently been the head womens basketball coach at Dickinson State University. Caleb was an assistant coach for the Lambuth University National Champion team in 2007. Harrison has coached players who have gone on to play professionally in the United States, Europe and Australia. Harrison has a masters degree in sports coaching from Indiana State University and a bachelor of sports coaching degree from the University of Canterbury.



Mark Dickel is currently the currently the Otago Regional Talent Programme head coach. He has played professional basketball since the age of 16 and continues to play today. Mark has played all over the world, from the USA at UNLV and in Australia/NZ and in Europe in Turkey, Russia, Greece, Germany and Poland. Mark played as an import in all these countries from 2001 to 2011. From 2010 to 2011 he was the head coach of the Albanian men's senior national team in Eurobasket.
