The Law Society of South Australia launched **The Naked Truth** app yesterday to spell out what is legal and what is not as it continues its push for a rethink of sexting and consent laws.

This is a very useful educational resource in a very topical and sensitive area for clubs and associations.

Topics dealt with in a simple and concise manner include:

- ☐ What is the age of consent?
- ☐ What constitutes an acceptable 'selfie'?
- ☐ When does it become pornography?
- ☐ When does it become a criminal offence and what are the consequences of conviction?
- ☐ The truth about Snapchat and Instagram?

The free app for smart phones has plain English legal definitions, case studies and quizzes.
