GSFNC is committed to contributing positively to the sport of netball in all facets. We aim to provide the best environment possible for players, coaches, umpires and everyone else to participate in, improve in and enjoy their sport. The club is run by a dedicated team of volunteers who are working to provide you with the opportunity to achieve your full potential as a netballer. In return we ask that you play your part in building the club's reputation by acting professionally and behaving respectfully towards all officials, administrators, players, coaches and spectators, whether from our club or from other clubs.

Players

- Play by the rules.
- Never argue with an official. If you disagree have your captain, coach or manager approach the official during a break or after the competition.
- Verbal abuse of officials and sledging other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent are not acceptable or permitted behaviors in any sport.
- Be a good sport. Applaud all good plays whether they are made by your team or the opposition.
- Treat all participants in your sport as you like to be treated
- Cooperate with your coach, team-mates and opponents, without them there would be no competition.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants
- Work equally hard for yourself and/or your team. Your team's performance will benefit and so will you.
- If you can't attend training or a game let your coach know well in advance

Parents/Spectators

- Remember, children learn best by example.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal abuse from sporting activities.
- Respect officials' decisions and teach children to do likewise.
- Show appreciation for volunteer coaches, officials and administrators. Without them, your child could not participate.
- Respect the rights and work of every person on the team

Coaches

- Remember that young people participate for pleasure and winning is only part of the fun.
- Operate within the rules and spirit of your sport and teach your players to do the same.
- Ensure the time players spend with you is appositve experience. All young people are deserving of equal attention and opportunities.
- Ensure equipment and facilities meets safety standards and are appropriate to the age and ability of all players.
- Display control, respect and professionalism to all involved with the sport. This includes opponents, coaches, officials, administrators, the media, parents and spectators.
- Encourage players to do the same.
- Show concern and caution toward sick and injured players.
- Follow the advice of a physician when determining whether an injured player is ready to recommence training or competition.
- Provide feedback to players in a caring and sensitive manner
- Obtain appropriate qualifications and keep up to date with the latest coaching practices and the principles of growth and development of young people.

Officials

- Modify rules and regulations to match the skill levels and needs of young people.
- Compliment and encourage all participants.
- Be consistent, objective and courteous when making decisions.
