### "Norm Griffiths 1917-2016 RIP"

Upper Gully early this season lost one of its last remaining links to the formation of the footy club with Norm Griffiths passing away at the age of 98. Norm attended the very first meeting of the Upper Ferntree Gully Football on the 14th October 1948 at Allens Tea Rooms, when he was elected as a committee member. Subsequently, Norm was named as Upper Gully Football Club's inaugural Captain and Coach in 1949 before handing the reigns over to Alec Cody early in the season. After retiring at the end of the 1953 season having played around 70 games, Norm became President for the 1954 season, which saw a lifelong friendship made with our first Premiership coach in Frank Lowrie who also started as coach during 1954. Norm continued as President until 1956 even making a comeback to the footy field during that season, finishing his playing career at Upper Gully with around 85 games. For Norm's contribution to the establishment of the Club he received a Life Membership at the Club Ball in 1952. Norm's brothers, Roy, Bill and Lawrie also played for Upper Gully during the early fifties, while Norm would go on to make many friendship's contributing and supporting Upper Gully over the following 60 years, including attending most reunions over the past decade.

# "Peter Ward 1954-2016 RIP"

The Upper Ferntree Gully Football Club was shocked by the sudden and recent passing of our dear friend Peter Ward. Wardy died from a stroke on the 14th April. His family have been heavily involved in the Upper Ferntree Gully Football Club, with all three boys Adam, Ben and Josh playing for the Club, Peter himself was our current Reserves Team Manager, a job he has performed since 2012, as well as interchange steward since 2011 and his wife Andrea our Head Trainer since 2010. Peter was always quick with a comment or a joke, used to good effect hosting Ladies Race Day functions and made the corner near the bar his own drinking his Melbourne Bitter Cans. He will be sadly missed by all associated with the Club.

### "Dawn Parker 1951-2016 RIP"

Upper Ferntree Gully Football Club extends its deepest sympathies to the family and friends of Dawn Parker who passed away peacefully a couple of weeks ago after a long illness. Dawn was heavily involved with the Footy club during the nineties performing the timekeeper's role as well as being on the committee between 1995 and 1996. Dawn's partner Steve Whyte was also involved with the club performing many varied tasks while Dawn's son Jason played with the club. Jason started at the Bluebirds before continuing with the U16's and U18's at the senior club, he then went on to play 2 senior and 68 reserves games between 1990 and 1996.


