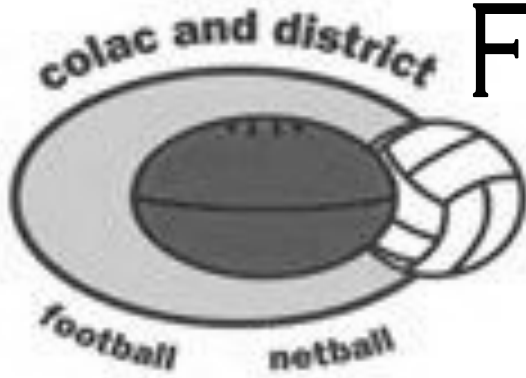
Once again hope you all have a great day, see you in the rooms after for a drink and a chat and later on at the RSL

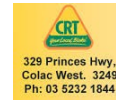
