MOSS VALE UNDER 16'S UNLEASH!

After a strong, but unrewarding start to the 2010 season, it was time for the U 16's to shake the proverbial monkey and get on the winners list. Round 3 saw Moss Vale U16 record their first win in the closely contested, high scoring, local derby against Bowral FC.

With the arrival of some talented players, notably, Daniel Stirton (Goal Keeper), Nick Tuddenham (centre mid & right mid) and Matt Flaus (left mid), Moss Vale's fire power was on display, scoring 3 goals per half.

Five minutes into the 1st half saw Chloe Beat the keeper in a 1 on 1, and casually slotted into the net for our first goal. Class! Bowral then hit back with two goals in the next 15 minutes but not long after, Tyson's decisive lob from just outside the halfway circle made it 2 – 2. Daniel then gave us the lead with a nice strike.

Early in the 2nd half, after a run and through ball from Nick, Shane cleverly put the ball into the bottom left corner of the goal. These two then reversed roles combining again a few minutes later with Nick scoring to extend the lead to 5 – 2! Again Bowral hit back with two quick goals to set us up for a nail biting finish at 5 – 4! However, Nick put the game beyond

doubt with another late goal to give Mossy a 6 – 4 win!

Moss Vale's improvement to play as a TEAM, coupled with the ability to bring on fresh players won them the match. The penny finally dropped with clever combinations between the midfield and the forwards. Defense overall was strong and tight marking of players with a commitment to back up, are vastly improving, however, as the score indicates, there is a need to shut down danger players. Daniel S impressed with some clinical saves off the line and a gallant one on one! Moss Vale now climbs off the bottom of the ladder moving into equal fifth with Bowral and Bundanoon. 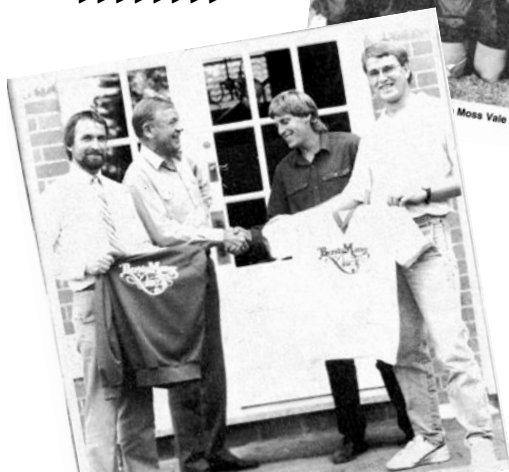


FIG 1. Craig Fryer, Andrew Haore, Paul Schmaltz, Mark "Chuck" Berry & Richard Easter (still playing 1st Grade)
