

Geoff's influence on the character and ability of Avoca's youth was starting to show now, not just

on the football field but also in the way many of them were maturing as young men.

After disposing of Natte-Bealiba in the second semi final, Avoca, captained by Paul Wardlaw, then crushed Navarre to win the Grand Final by 66 points and become Premiers and Champions. (undefeated) **UNDER 16 GRAND FINAL**

The Under 14 girls were also premiers and champions and toppled Navarre in the Grand Final 18 goals to 9 goals.


The Reserves girls were defeated in the Grand Final by Navarre 19 goals to 23 goals.
