In 1990, Dorrie was rewarded for the years of devotion to the club with Life membership.

Dorrie was president of the Netball Club in 1975 and again in 1980. She umpired for many years, but was probably best known as our very successful junior coach. 18 Grand Final Teams.

She coached our 3rds and 4<sup>th</sup>'s teams for 14 years straight from 1968 to 1981 and again coached the 3rds and 4<sup>th</sup>'s in 1990 with her daughter Christine resulting in the thirds being Runners Up and the 4ths winning the premiership.

She coached the 4ths on her own in 1991 to an undefeated Premiers and Champions season.

She coached 14 premierships for our club with two premiers and champions. And she also coached four Runner Up teams.

Dorrie could be considered a club legend for her extraordinary contribution to our club.

She has won the Avoca FNC A Grade Best & Fairest in 1999, 2000, 2001, 2002, 2004, 2005, 2006 and 2014.



She has also won the Avoca FNC Best & Fairest in the Under 14 in 1992, and the Under 17 in 1994.

Stacey has played over 450 games for the club and played in Nine premierships for Avoca in various grades over the past 32 years. (Minus a few years for Maternity leave)

She is a Life member of the Avoca FNC and also the MCDFNL.

This is a fantastic effort and we thank Stacey for her ongoing service over many years.
